



Clear Photos

Have 3-5 photos readily available that clearly show your dog's face, body and unique markings or colorings.



Microchip

Make sure your dog's microchip is registered to you with current contact information. If possible use multiple contact methods.



Collar & ID Tag

Keep a collar with a readable tag on your dog at all times. Ensure your name and phone number are printed on the tag.



Social Media

Join local lost pet social media groups so they are easy to access when needed.



Scent Items

Keep a worn shirt, pillowcase, or blanket in a bag so you have a strong scent item ready.



Neighborhood Awareness

Know your neighborhood's escape routes, wooded areas, and quiet hiding spots. J.



Local Contacts

Save numbers for Animal Control, local shelters, and your vet in your phone.



Safe Space Plan

Identify where you would place a crate, bedding, or food station outside if your dog ever slipped out.
